**BLUESKY EXPERIENCES LIMITED**  
**RULES FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE BLUESKY CHALLENGE**

These Rules regulate the admission of prospective participants to the BlueSky Challenge at Drumlanrig Castle (The Venue). The authority to enforce the Rules is vested in James England and Suzie England of BlueSky Experiences Limited and in any employees of BlueSky Experiences Limited or anyone to whom such authority shall be delegated (“the Organisers”).

The Rules are:-

1. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse admittance to any individual or groups of individuals whom they consider to be unruly, intoxicated, under the influence of drugs or who might otherwise pose a threat or danger to themselves or to other persons participating in the events at the Venue.
2. Where Protective clothing, headgear and other safety aids are provided and must be worn by participants at all times under the direction of the Organisers.
3. All instructions from the Organisers or those acting on their authority in supervising activities must be strictly adhered to by participants.
4. Any person suffering from any ailment or physical or mental disability or who is taking medication must report such facts to the Organisers who will have the sole discretion whether to permit participation of such individuals in all or any activities or to impose conditions upon such participation.
5. No-one who in the opinion of the Organisers is under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be permitted to participate in any activities.
6. Any person who fails to obey the Organisers instructions or who wilfully or negligently damages equipment or in the opinion of the Organisers places himself or others in a position of unnecessary danger may be excluded from the Venue.
7. All participants must keep to the areas designated for said activities by the Organisers.
8. All participants' vehicles must be parked within designated parking areas at the Venue.
9. Any participator whose behaviour is in the opinion of the Organisers inappropriate for continued participation in the activities at the Venue may be asked to leave the Venue.
10. Any participant who causes damage to the equipment, the Organisers or other participators whilst acting in breach of any of these Rules may be held personally responsible for such damage and may be required by the Organisers to leave the Venue.
